EVENT VENUE

Host city: Plovdiv

Location: Plovdiv is the second-largest city in Bulgaria, administrative center of the region, situated on the two banks of the Maritsa River, southeast of the Bulgarian capital, Sofia. It is an important economic, transport, cultural, sports and educational center. The city has historically developed on seven hills, some of which are 250 meters






TRANSPORT

Plovdiv's geographical position makes it an international transport hub. Three of the ten Pan-European corridors run into or near the city: Corridor IV (Dresden-Bucharest-Sofia-Plovdiv- Istanbul), Corridor VIII (Durrës-Sofia-Plovdiv-Varna/Burgas), and Corridor X (Salzburg-Belgrade-Plovdiv-Istanbul). The city is a major road and railway hub in Southern Bulgaria with the Trakia motorway (A1) only 5 km to the north.

Plovdiv International Airport is near the village of Krumovo, 5 km southeast of the city. Plovdiv is located 145 km away from the airport of the capital Sofia by A1, 259 km away from Burgas airport by A1, and 370 km away from Varna airport.



All events associated with the World Championship for Veterans, Masters and Disabled (opening ceremony, captains meetings, award ceremony and closing banquet) will take place in Plovdiv.



OFFICIAL FISHING VENUE

Water area: Rowing channel - Plovdiv

Location: The channel is located near the Recreation and Culture Park,

next to the Plovdiv Stadium

Length: 2200 m

Width: 120 m

Depth: 2.5 m in all sectors



Competitions: Every year there are held competitions of the National Sports Fishing Championship in Bulgaria. In 2016 this channel took place the 63th FISHING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP FOR NATIONS and in 2021 the 4th WORLD FEEDER FISHING CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLUBS



FISH SPECIES

There are these types of fish in the Rowing channel:

Carp (cyprinus carpio), **crucian** (carassius carassius), **amur** (Ctenopharyngodon idella), **roach** (rutilus rutilus), **chub** (leuciscus cephalus)

The fishing of **silver carp** (Hypophthalmichthys molitrix) is prohibited and will not be counted







LIMITATIONS AND REGULATIONS

The age limits for belonging to the "MASTERS" and "VETERANS" categories are as follows:

- **MASTERS:** be 55 years old on December 31 of the year preceding the championship.
- **VETERANS:** be 65 years old on December 31 of the year preceding the championship.

Athletes over 65, who therefore belong to the VETERANS category, can be part of the MASTERS category, the reverse not being possible.



In all cases, athletes over 75 on December 31 of the year preceding the championship must present a medical certificate attesting to their good state of health.

Competitors born between 1959 and 1968 inclusive will therefore be admitted to the MASTERS category, while those born between 1948 and 1958 inclusive will be able to participate in the VETERANS category.

BAITS AND GROUNDBAITS QUANTITIES

DISABLED

Groundbait quantity: 15 liters. Prepared groundbaits (wet and sieved) should be placed in graduated buckets. This quantity includes soil, gravel, seeds (corn, wheat, hemp, etc.) and other additives that are not toxic to wildlife and the aquatic environment.

Quantity of baits: 2 liters, including a maximum of 0.50 liters of jokers. A maximum quantity of 0.50 liters of earthworms is allowed in the total bait. Earthworms must be presented whole (not cut).

Bloodworms are for the hook only and must be presented in an "official FIPSed size" box. After control, the bloodworms intended for the hook can be used for baiting

VETERANS-MASTERS

Groundbait quantity: 20 litres. Prepared groundbaits (wet and sieved) should be placed in graduated buckets. This quantity includes soil, gravel, seeds (corn, wheat, hemp, etc.) and other additives that are not toxic to wildlife and the aquatic environment.

Quantity of baits: 2.5 liters including a maximum of 0.50 liters of jokers. A maximum quantity of 0.50 liters of earthworms is allowed in the total bait. Earthworms must be presented whole (not cut).

Bloodworms are for the hook only and must be presented in an "official FIPSed size" box. After the check, the bloodworms intended for the hook can be used for baiting.

The meshes of the basket must not exceed 10 mm by 10 mm. The keepnet must have a minimum diameter of 40 cm for the round ones, a minimum diagonal of 50 cm for the rectangular ones and a minimum length of 3.50 m.

REGISTRATION FEE

Registration fee for Masters and Veterans: 1450 euro per team (5 competitors, 2 Captains, 1 Delegate), which includes the FIPSed fee 150 euro per team, the closing banquet, 5 fishing permits for the whole duration of the championship (training and competitions), insurance, souvenirs etc.

Registration fee for Disabled: 1300 euro per team (5 competitors, 2 Captains, 1 Delegate), which includes the closing banquet, 5 fishing permits for the whole duration of the championship (training and competitions), insurance, souvenirs etc.

The cost of one banquet for any additional person (exceeding 8 persons) is $60 \in$.

The Federations, in addition to the medals devoted to the official members of the Delegation, will be allowed to ask for extra medals (up to a maximum of 3 per team), upon payment of a contribution of \in 25 per extra medal, which will also include the diploma.

The fees for extra medals shall be paid to F.I.P.S.e.d. In no case and for no reason extra medals in a number higher than that provided by these Rules may be requested from F.I.P.S.e.d.



ANTI-DOPING INFORMATION TUE REQUESTS

The athletes participating in the Championship, with the registration, implicitly accept all WADA anti-doping rules. Athlete whose illness or condition requires treatment with a prohibited substance or method must apply to CIPS for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) following the CIPS strict TUE application process.

He/she shall then use the application form, which can be downloaded from the ITA website: https://ita.sport/resource/international-testing-agency-therapeutic-use-exemption-tue-application-form/

The TUE request has to be sent to the following address: tue@ita.sport

Athletes must therefore consult the Prohibited List https://www.wada-ama.org/en/resources/world-anti-doping-code-and-international-standards/prohibited-list

If the TUE is granted, the athlete will then be permitted to use the medication during the period of validity of the TUE without committing an Anti-Doping Rules Violation (ADRV).

Regardless of whether a TUE has been granted or not, athletes should always declare on the doping control forms filled out during sample collection any medications and supplements taken within the seven days prior to sample collection, and any blood transfusions in the three months prior for blood samples.

If a TUE has already been granted by a NADO or by a RADO, the Athlete in question does not have to apply for any additional CIPS TUE, as CIPS recognizes all TUE granted by NADOs and RADOs.
